**MICHIGAN NONPROFIT ASSOCIATION ANNOUNCES
REPRESENTATIVE JULIE CALLEY AS NONPROFIT CAUCUS CO-CHAIR**

LANSING, Michigan – Michigan Nonprofit Association (MNA), a state-wide membership organization dedicated to serving the nonprofit sector, today announced that Representative Julie Calley (R-87, Portland) has been named co-chair of the Michigan Nonprofit Caucus, filling the vacancy left by term-limited Representative Amanda Price.



The Michigan Nonprofit Caucus is a bipartisan, bicameral group focused on legislative and regulatory issues that impact nonprofit organizations and foundations in Michigan. The aim of the caucus is to support Michigan’s nonprofit sector through legislative action such as tax policy, budget and spending, and public-private collaborations.

Calley holds positions on the Transportation and Infrastructure, Health Policy, Agriculture, and Elections and Ethics committees. She has formerly served as chair of the Michigan Community Service Commission, and vice-chair of The Right Door, a behavioral healthcare organization based in Ionia County.

Calley joins continuing co-chairs Senators Bert Johnson, John Proos, Wayne Schmidt, and Rebekah Warren, and Representatives Stephanie Chang, Vanessa Guerra, and Rob VerHeulen.

“Representative Calley’s knowledge and experience make her an ideal fit for the Nonprofit Caucus. We look forward to working with her on policies that benefit nonprofits and the people they serve in our communities,” said MNA President & CEO Donna Murray-Brown.
