Over 500 Students to Receive Michigan Campus Compact Award for Community Service

April 8, 2014 – Lansing, MI - Michigan Nonprofit Association (MNA) today announced that Michigan Campus Compact (MiCC) will honor over 500 students from 34 campuses for their community service during the 18th annual Outstanding Student Service Awards Celebration. The awards brunch will take place on April 12, 2014, at the Kellogg Hotel and Conference Center in East Lansing, MI from 11:00 to 2:00pm.

Each year, MiCC awards students from member colleges and universities across the state for their outstanding commitment to service-learning and civic engagement. Three types of awards are given: the Outstanding Community Impact Award, which will recognize seven students who have made service an integral part of their college experience through significant contributions to community resources; the Commitment to Service Award, which will recognize thirty-six students for the breadth or depth of their community involvement or service experiences; and the Heart and Soul Award, which will recognize students for their time, effort and personal commitment to their communities through service.
